

Project Description:

The Department has prepared a draft permit and has made a tentative determination to issue a renewed Air State Facility permit which has been updated to reflect current activities at the facility to Hillcrest Industries, Inc. located in the Village of Attica, Wyoming County. This facility manufactures blasting media and reflective glass beads by drying, grinding and sizing industrial coal boiler slag, post-consumer glass, and waste glass. The facility has two emission units: Emission Unit A is the grinding room and Emission Unit B contains the two natural gas fired glass bead furnaces. Emission Unit A contains emission points 00001 and 00004 which exhaust through filtration systems and maintain the required negative pressure in the grinding room to insure fugitive emissions are not released to the environment. Emission Unit B contains emission points 00002 and 00003 - the two glass bead furnaces, which exhaust through filtration systems. The facility is under an Order on Consent, which includes a compliance schedule, Schedule A, that includes operational requirements and the submission of emission minimization plans. These include monitoring stockpiles for dust, storing fine screenings in containers, inspecting and repairing material conveying systems and emission control equipment, monitoring emission points for visible emissions, and keeping the grinding room under a negative pressure. The emission minimization plans for the above include monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting requirements as well. The on-going air-related activities and the monitoring and maintenance activities are included in the draft permit.

As a tentative determination, the Department is seeking public comments prior to making a final decision on permit issuance.

Availability of Application Documents:

Filed application documents, and Department draft permits where applicable, are available for inspection during normal business hours at the address of the contact person. To ensure timely service at the time of inspection, it is recommended that an appointment be made with the contact person.
