24-1 Permit required for pumps adjoining sidewalks and curbs

No person or corporation shall erect or construct, or cause to be erected or constructed, any pump or device designed to dispense gasoline, motor oil or petroleum products adjoining sidewalks or curbs within the boundaries of the streets of the Village of Attica, unless the owner of the property in front of which said pump or device is desired first obtains a written license or permit so to do from the Board of Trustees of said Village of Attica, signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Clerk. Such a permit when so obtained may be assigned by the owner of said property.

24-2 Violations and penalties

Any violation of this chapter is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars.

24-3. When effective.

This ordinance is to take effect after due posting and publication, pursuant to law.
